### **H\*2021 (Rat #0431, Act #0401 of 1988) General Bill, By Harvin, P.T. Bradley, T.M. Burriss and R.S. Corning**

A Bill to amend Section 47-1-40, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to ill-treatment of animals, so as to further provide for what constitutes ill-treatment and to increase the penalties for violation, to also make it unlawful to torture, mutilate, or cruelly kill animals and to provide penalties for violation, and to provide certain exceptions.-amended title
