**S\*0275 (Rat #0082, Act #0051 of 1987) General Bill, By Drummond**

***Similar (H 2230)***

A Bill to amend Section 50-9-830, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to blind persons, orphans, and Boy and Girl Scouts being exempt from hunting and fishing license requirements under certain conditions, so as to include mentally retarded persons within the provisions of this Section.
