### H 3200 General Bill, By T.A. Limehouse

A Bill to amend Section 56-1-430, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to appeal acting as a supersedeas for sixty days from the date of conviction for an offense making mandatory the suspension or revocation of a driver's license, so as to make the supersedeas apply during the pendency of the appeal.
