H*3224 (Rat #0628, Act #0514 of 1984) General Bill, By Kirsh and P.T. Bradley

A Bill to amend Section 17-5-220, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the establishment and functions of medical examiner commissions, so as to decrease from two hundred forty thousand or more to one hundred thousand or more the population required of the counties in which are created medical examiner commissions.
