

## Session 103 - (1979-1980)

### H\*3232 (Rat #0626, Act #0505 of 1980) General Bill, By J.H. Toal

A Bill to provide that any state employee, who is injured as a result of criminal conduct of another while engaged in assigned duties as a State Law Enforcement Officer or an employee of any State Correctional Institution and such injury renders such person incapable of performing his work as a state employee, shall continue to receive full state compensation for a period of one year or such lesser period as his incapacity continues without prejudice to his right to obtain Workmen's Compensation benefits in appropriate circumstances.
