### **Similar (S 0390)**

A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 44-69-77 so as to allow a licensed continuing care retirement community that operates a home health agency and a nursing home to share certain services between the home health agency and the nursing home; and to amend Section 44-69-75, relating to requiring a home health agency to obtain a certificate of need before being licensed, so as to exempt certain continuing care retirement communities from obtaining a certificate of need to provide home health services to its residents if certain conditions are met.-amended title
