A Concurrent Resolution to memorialize the Congress of the United States to take necessary action to insure that the Federal Migratory Waterfowl Regulations for 1989 allow ducks and geese to be hunted thirty minutes before sunrise during open season instead of at sunrise as the 1988 regulations provided.
