A Bill to amend Section 38-53-170, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to unlawful acts regarding bail bondsmen and runners, so as to delete the provision that loitering in or about a magistrate's office or any place where prisoners are confined is *prima facie* evidence of soliciting, to provide that judicial officers, law enforcement officers, and jailers have full responsibility, power, and authority to enforce certain provisions of Section 38-53-170, and to require that any action taken pursuant to certain provisions of Section 38-53-170 resulting in a conviction, guilty plea, or plea of *nolo contendere* must be reported to the Chief Insurance Commissioner.
