**H 3481 General Bill, By Lanford, H. Brown, H.H. Clyborne, J.D. Cole, Davenport, Haskins, T.A. Limehouse, D.A. Moss and S.S. Wofford**

A Bill to amend Section 44-63-40, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to vital statistics, so as to require county coroners to issue burial-removal-transit permits for violent and accidental deaths occurring outside hospitals, nursing homes, or other institutions.
