### **S 0365 Joint Resolution, By C.T. Hinson**

#### ***Similar (H 2034)***

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Article XVII of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, which contains various miscellaneous provisions, so as to provide that the English language is the official language of the State of South Carolina, prohibit the State or any political subdivision of this State from using any language other than English, and provide exceptions.
