A Bill to amend Section 20-7-1015, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the counsel for an obligee in a civil enforcement action of a South Carolina child support order, so as to provide that the prosecuting attorney shall represent the State rather than the obligee in these matters.
