H 3731 General Bill, By Knotts, Davenport, Gourdine, Littlejohn and Moody-Lawrence

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 8-11-955 SO AS TO ELIMINATE ANNUAL COST OF LIVING SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR A CLASSIFIED STATE EMPLOYEE EARNING OVER SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS A YEAR IN SALARY AND MAKE THE EMPLOYEE ELIGIBLE FOR AN ANNUAL BONUS OF NOT MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS IF HIS ANNUAL REVIEW IS "EXCEEDS" OR GREATER, TO CAP UNCLASSIFIED EXECUTIVE SALARIES AT CURRENT PAY, WITH ELIGIBILITY FOR AN ANNUAL "INITIATIVE BONUS" OF NOT MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS ON APPROVAL OF THEIR EMPLOYING AUTHORITY, TO LIMIT SALARY INCREASES FOR PERSONS REVIEWED BY THE AGENCY HEAD SALARY COMMISSION TO THE ANNUAL PAY INCREASE PLAN FOR STATE EMPLOYEES AND REQUIRE ALL NEW HIRES FOR POSITIONS SUBJECT TO COMMISSION REVIEW TO BE AT THE MINIMUM SALARY FOR THE POSITION.
