H*3808 (Rat #0259, Act #0153 of 1993) General Bill, By T.E. Huff, A.W. Byrd, Phillips and R. Smith

A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 59-30-11 so as to provide that by September 1, 1993, the State Department of Education shall develop an alternative assessment mechanism to the written portion of the exit exam for those students who have documented disabilities, such as severe to profound hearing disability or English as a second language, and to provide that until this alternative is developed, passing the written portion of the exit exam is waived for the purposes of receiving a state high school diploma for those students who have performed above average on other measures of achievement and who are otherwise qualified to receive the diploma.-amended title
