S 0393 General Bill, By Fair

Summary: Driver's license renewals

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-210, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED TO OR RENEWED FOR CERTAIN PERSONS WHO ARE LESS THAN SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE IS VALID FOR TEN YEARS, AND TO ALLOW CERTAIN PERSONS TO HAVE THEIR DRIVER'S LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE EXTENDED FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEARS AND NOT REQUIRE THEM TO COMPLETE A VISION TEST; TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-140, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE FEE FOR AND CONTENTS OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE FEE FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE THAT IS VALID FOR FIVE YEARS OR WHOSE EXTENDED VALIDITY IS FOR FIVE YEARS IS TWELVE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE FEE FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE THAT IS VALID FOR TEN YEARS IS TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS.
