

## Session 113 - (1999-2000)

### **H\*3960 (Rat #0099, Act #0053 of 1999) General Bill, By Barfield, Rhoad and Witherspoon**

**Summary:** Trotlines, sethooks, single-barbed; nongame fish and bream; Fish and Game

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 50-13-1187, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO BAIT THAT MAY BE USED WITH TROT LINES, SET HOOKS, AND JUGS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT LIVE NONGAME FISH AND BREEM MAY BE USED WITH SINGLE-BARBED SET HOOKS, INCLUDING ON TROT LINES HAVING NOT MORE THAN TWENTY HOOKS, THAT HAVE A SHANK-TO-POINT GAP OF ONE AND THREE-SIXTEENTHS INCHES OR GREATER ON THE BLACK, BIG PEE DEE, LITTLE PEE DEE, LUMBER AND WACCAMAW RIVERS, TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL TO HAVE MORE THAN THIRTY BREEM IN POSSESSION WHEN FISHING ON THESE RIVERS, TO PROVIDE THAT BREEM MAY NOT BE USED AS BAIT AFTER JUNE 30, 2001, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES.-AMENDED TITLE
