**H\*3984 (Rat #0296, Act #0291 of 1994) General Bill, By J.G. McAbee**

***Similar (S 0765, S 1065)***

A Bill to amend Section 12-36-2120, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to sales tax exemptions, so as to exempt the sale of tangible personal property sold to charitable hospitals predominantly serving children which are also exempt from the property tax, where care is provided without charge to the patient.
