### H 4124 General Bill, By Spires and Taylor

**Summary:** Annual Capital City Softball Classic

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 2-1-240 SO AS TO PROVIDE THE ANNUAL CAPITAL CITY SOFTBALL CLASSIC BETWEEN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE CONSIST OF ONE TEAM COMPRISED OF AT LEAST SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND ONE TEAM COMPRISED OF AT LEAST SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE SENATE, ALL OF WHOM MUST ACTIVELY PLAY DURING THE ENTIRE GAME; TO PROVIDE THAT THE GAME BE OFFICIATED BY THREE REFEREES SELECTED FROM CANDIDATES ACTIVELY SEEKING JUDICIAL OFFICE SO AS TO VIEW THE EXERCISE OF THEIR JUDGMENT IN THE HEAT OF BATTLE; AND TO PROVIDE THAT IF A TEAM FAILS TO HAVE THE REQUISITE NUMBER OF QUALIFIED PLAYERS IN AN INNING, THE OTHER TEAM IS AWARDED A NUMBER OF RUNS EQUAL TO THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS THE VIOLATING TEAM FIELDS AND THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS REQUIRED.
