H 4289 Joint Resolution, By J.H. Neal

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 13, ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO ELECTION OF JUDGES TO THE CIRCUIT COURT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF EACH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT SHALL ELECT THE JUDGES FOR THE JUDICIAL CIRCUITS IN THE MANNER THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL PROVIDE, AND TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS SERVING AS CIRCUIT JUDGES ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE PROVISION PROVIDING FOR THE POPULAR ELECTION OF CIRCUIT JUDGES SHALL CONTINUE TO SERVE FOR THE TERM FOR WHICH THEY WERE ELECTED.
