AN ACT TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 38-61-70 SO AS TO DEFINE A "COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY", "CONSTRUCTION PROFESSIONAL", AND "CONSTRUCTION RELATED WORK", TO PROVIDE THAT A COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY MUST DEFINE OR BE DEEMED TO DEFINE THE WORD "OCCURRENCE" IN A SPECIFIC MANNER, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE SCOPE AND LIMITS OF APPLICABILITY OF THIS SECTION. - ratified title
