H 4578 Joint Resolution, By Wilkins, B.O. Baker, Cato, H.H. Clyborne, Fair, M.F. Jaskwhich and Vaughn *Similar (S 1028)*

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Article III, Section 2 of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, relating to the House of Representatives, so as to provide that House members may serve only three two-year terms and to provide that House members serving in office when this provision is ratified into law may complete the term which they are currently serving plus three new terms thereafter; proposing an amendment to Article III, Section 6 of the Constitution, relating to the Senate, so as to provide that Senators may serve only two four-year terms, to provide that Senators serving in office when this provision is ratified into law may complete the term which they are currently serving plus two new terms thereafter, and to revise certain obsolete references.
