H 4681 General Bill, By Funderburk

Summary: Workers' compensation

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 42-5-40, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO A PENALTY FOR FAILURE OF AN EMPLOYER TO SECURE WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE FOR ITS EMPLOYEES, SO AS TO REQUIRE THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION TO SEND A LETTER TO THE EMPLOYER GIVING HIM THIRTY DAYS BEFORE A PENALTY SHALL APPLY WHILE A CLAIM IS PENDING, AND PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSION MAY PROMULGATE REGULATIONS BY WHICH AN EMPLOYER NOT ACTING IN GOOD FAITH WHILE FAILING TO SECURE WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE SHALL NOT BE OFFERED THE BENEFITS OF THE THIRTY-DAY GRACE PERIOD PROVIDED ABOVE.
