A Bill to amend Section 50-13-235, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the prohibition against the taking of striped bass less than twenty-one inches under certain conditions, so as to further provide for those rivers, reservoirs, and their tributaries where it is unlawful to take or possess striped bass less than twenty-one inches.-amended title
