**Summary:** Bodily fluids, felony violation for person in custody or under arrest to throw on law enforcement officers or correctional facility employees

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 24-13-470, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE UNLAWFUL THROWING OF BODY FLUIDS ON AN EMPLOYEE OF A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY BY AN INMATE, AND THE PENALTIES IMPOSED UPON A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THIS SECTION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IN ADDITION TO AN INMATE, THIS PROVISION ALSO APPLIES TO A DETAINEE, A PERSON TAKEN INTO CUSTODY, OR A PERSON UNDER ARREST WHO THROWS CERTAIN BODY FLUIDS ON AN EMPLOYEE OF A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR A STATE OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A VISITOR OF A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR ANY OTHER PERSON AUTHORIZED TO BE PRESENT IN A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON ACCUSED OF A CRIME AS CONTAINED IN THIS SECTION MAY BE TESTED FOR CERTAIN DISEASES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN PATIENTS.-amended title
