H*4791 (Rat #0355, Act #0532 of 1996) Joint Resolution, By Walker, Allison, Cato, Davenport, Lanford, Lee, Littlejohn, Phillips, D. Smith and C.C. Wells

A Joint Resolution to provide that certain school days missed by students of specified school districts in Spartanburg County for school year 1995-96 when the schools were closed due to weather or other conditions are exempted from the make-up requirement of the defined minimum plan that full school days missed due to extreme weather or other circumstances be made up.
