H*4801 (Rat #0395, Act #0330 of 1996) General Bill, By Meacham

A Bill to amend Section 8-13-1356, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the requirement that a candidate for public office file a statement of economic interests at the time the candidate files a declaration of candidacy or a petition for nomination and other filing requirements, so as to exempt a public official from the provisions of this Section if he has a current statement of economic interests on file with his supervisory office required by Sections 8-13-1110 or 8-13-1140.-amended title
