Summary: Constitutional amendment, judges, provisions for removing

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 17, ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO REMOVAL OR RETIREMENT OF JUDGES, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL METHOD OF REMOVING A JUDGE BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AFTER AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL MERIT SELECTION COMMISSION AND A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE COMMISSION FOR REMOVAL FOR MALFEASANCE, MISFEASANCE, INCOMPETENCY, ABSENTEEISM, CONFLICTS OF INTEREST, MISCONDUCT, PERSISTENT NEGLECT OF DUTY IN OFFICE, OR INCAPACITY.
