H 4998 Joint Resolution, By Mitchell, F.N. Smith, Govan, Davenport, Alexander, Hodges and Weeks

Summary: County jails

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO DIRECT THE JAILS AND LOCAL DETENTION FACILITIES IN SPARTANBURG, SUMTER, AND BAMBERG COUNTIES FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE MONTHS TO OBTAIN FROM PERSONS WHO ARE ARRESTED AND DETAINED A RAPID ORAL OR BLOOD SAMPLE, OR BOTH, TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PERSON IS INFECTED WITH THE HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV), TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL (DHEC) SHALL PROVIDE CERTAIN SERVICES TO A PERSON WHO TESTS POSITIVE FOR HIV, TO PROVIDE THAT DHEC SHALL COMPILE A REPORT THAT CONTAINS CERTAIN DATA WHICH IT COMPILES DURING THIS TWELVE MONTH PERIOD, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE MEDICAL, MILITARY, PUBLIC AND MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, THE SENATE MEDICAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, AND THE GOVERNOR MUST BE FORWARDED COPIES OF THIS REPORT.
