### **S 0511 General Bill, By G. Smith and M.B. Williams**

A Bill to amend Section 50-13-1750, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to game fish breeder's licenses, so as to provide that licensed individuals may sell, offer for sale, and transport cultured game fish to stock or restock private ponds; to provide that cultured game fish four inches or larger must be produced from South Carolina raised brood stock; and to provide a definition for cultured game fish.
