A Bill to amend Section 29-5-10, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to mechanics' liens, so as to include plan preparation, specifications, and design drawings within the definition of "labor performed" under this Section and to provide that the prevailing party in an action to enforce the lien may recover costs and attorneys' fees and to provide a procedure for settling claims and determining who is the prevailing party; to amend Section 29-5-20, relating to mechanics' and other materialmen's liens, so as to provide that the prevailing party in an action to enforce the lien may recover costs and attorneys' fees and to provide a procedure for settling claims and determining who is the prevailing party.-amended title
