Summary: Pyrotechnics Deregulation Act

A BILL TO ENACT THE "PYROTECHNICS DEREGULATION ACT" BY AMENDING SECTION 23-35-45, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO INDOOR USE OF PYROTECHNICS, SO AS TO UPDATE THE EDITION THAT MUST BE UTILIZED IN SUCH USE OF PYROTECHNICS; BY AMENDING SECTIONS 23-35-50 AND 23-35-70, BOTH AS AMENDED, AND SECTIONS 23-36-140 AND 23-35-150, ALL RELATING TO VARIOUS RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE STATE BOARD OF PYROTECHNIC SAFETY, SO AS TO TRANSFER THESE RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL AND TO PROVIDE THAT PYROTECHNIC LICENSES AND PERMITS MUST BE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING AND REGULATION; AND TO REPEAL CHAPTER 56, TITLE 40, RELATING TO THE CREATION, POWERS, AND DUTIES OF THE STATE BOARD OF PYROTECHNIC SAFETY.
