Summary: Employers, employees benefits and claims; unemployed unemployment compensation; Employment Security Commission

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 41-27-310, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF AN INSURED WORKER; TO AMEND SECTION 41-27-370 TO PROVIDE THAT THERE WILL BE NO PENSION REDUCTION IN WEEKLY BENEFITS IF THE RECIPIENT HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THE PENSION PLAN; TO AMEND SECTION 41-35-130 RELATING TO THE CHARGING OF BENEFITS TO FORMER EMPLOYERS; TO AMEND SECTION 41-41-20 TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO REDUCE BENEFIT PAYMENTS TO CLAIMANTS WHO HAVE MADE FRAUDULENT MISREPRESENTATIONS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 41-41-40 TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO COLLECT BENEFITS OVERPAID BY STATES ADMINISTERING COMPARABLE UNEMPLOYMENT LAWS FROM BENEFITS PAID IN SOUTH CAROLINA AND TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION TO WAIVE OVERPAYMENTS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES FOR WHICH THE CLAIMANT IS NOT AT FAULT AND TO SPECIFY A FIVE-YEAR STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS.
