A Bill to provide for the classification of property qualifying for the homestead exemption pursuant to Section 12-37-250, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, (Taxpayers sixty-five or over, totally and permanently disabled or legally blind), as residential and the taxation of such property on an assessment equal to four percent of the property's fair market value.
