A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO URGE THE FEDERAL RESERVE TO MAINTAIN ITS PROCESSING CENTER IN COLUMBIA, SOUTH CAROLINA, AND TO CONSOLIDATE SERVICES INTO THE COLUMBIA OFFICE BECAUSE OF ITS DEMONSTRATED EFFICIENT OPERATION AND ITS ESTABLISHED AND HIGHLY QUALIFIED EMPLOYEES RATHER THAN RELOCATING THE CENTER TO CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA.
