Summary: Certain inmates may apply for medical furlough

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 24-3-210, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE GRANTING OF FURLOUGHS TO CERTAIN INMATES CONFINED IN THE STATE PRISON SYSTEM, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN INMATES MAY APPLY FOR A MEDICAL FURLOUGH UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO PROVIDE THAT AN INMATE WHO RECEIVES A FURLOUGH PURSUANT TO THIS PROVISION MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH AN ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICE.
