A Bill to amend Section 44-53-110, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, relating to narcotics and controlled substances, so as to define paraphernalia as used in administering or preparing marijuana, hashish and oils thereof and cocaine, to provide certain exceptions, to include paraphernalia in the definition of deliver or delivery and to amend the Code by adding Section 44-53-391, so as to make it unlawful to advertise for sale, manufacture, possess, sell or deliver or to possess with the intent to sell or deliver paraphernalia.
