Summary: Employment verification

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 8-14-20, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT PUBLIC EMPLOYERS VERIFY THE EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION OF EMPLOYEES, SO AS TO ALLOW THE EMPLOYMENT OF WORKERS WHO POSSESS A VALID UNITED STATES PASSPORT, MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A UNITED STATES MILITARY DEPENDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD; AND TO AMEND SECTION 41-8-20, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO SOUTH CAROLINA EMPLOYMENT LICENSES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A UNITED STATES PASSPORT, MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A UNITED STATES MILITARY DEPENDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD MAY BE USED FOR EMPLOYER VERIFICATION PURPOSES.
