Summary: University of South Carolina-Spartanburg to become Spartanburg University, Colleges and Universities

A BILL TO AMEND TITLE 59, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO EDUCATION BY ADDING CHAPTER 134, SO AS TO CREATE THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA AT SPARTANBURG AS SPARTANBURG UNIVERSITY, A SEPARATE AND DISTINCT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA; TO CREATE ITS BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS POWERS AND DUTIES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS; AND TO PROVIDE TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS.
