Summary: Motor vehicle accidents

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 56-5-1370 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT THAT RESULTS IN THE INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A DOG, CAT, OR HORSE SHALL STOP THE VEHICLE AT THE SCENE OF THE ACCIDENT AND REPORT THE ACCIDENT TO THE PROPER LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.
