A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 59-65-10 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO MANDATORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE, TO PROVIDE THAT A CHILD MUST ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL THE CHILD ATTAINS THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN, GRADUATES FROM HIGH SCHOOL, OR RECEIVES A HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA, AND TO AMEND CHAPTER 7, TITLE 20, TO PROVIDE THAT A CHILD CAN BE CONVICTED OF TRUANCY UNTIL THE CHILD REACHES EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.
