Summary: Controlled substances

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING ARTICLE 2 TO CHAPTER 43, TITLE 40 SO AS TO TRANSFER CERTAIN RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY OVER THE REGULATION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL TO THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY; TO AMEND SECTIONS 44-53-1630, 44-53-1640, AS AMENDED, AND 44-130-60, AS AMENDED, ALL RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, SO AS TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES; AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 44-53-280, 44-53-290, 44-53-300, 44-53-310, 44-53-320, 44-53-330, 44-53-340, 44-53-350, 44-53-360, 44-53-361, 44-53-362, 44-53-363, AND 44-53-365, ALL RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE REGULATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL.
