A Bill to amend Sections 44-17-420 and 44-17-550, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to hearings required for mentally ill persons, so as to delete the exclusion of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays in determining the time requirements for notice of the hearings.
