Summary: Nationally recognized building codes, adoption and enforcement of; Agencies, State, Government, Buildings

A BILL TO AMEND TITLE 1, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT BY ADDING CHAPTER 34, SO AS TO REQUIRE ALL STATE AGENCIES CHARGED WITH THE REGULATION OF BUILDINGS OR OTHER STRUCTURES BY ENFORCING A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CODE TO ADOPT THE LATEST EDITION OF THE APPLICABLE CODE, TO PROVIDE PROCEDURES FOR THE ADOPTION OF SUCH CODES AND APPENDICES, AND TO PROHIBIT AN AGENCY FROM ENFORCING A NATIONAL CODE TO THE EXTENT IT IS INCONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW.
