S 0013 Joint Resolution, By Kuhn, Ford, Mescher, Elliott and Ravenel

Summary: Constitutional amendment, property tax, maximum amount to tax 1% of assessed value

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO FINANCE AND TAXATION, BY ADDING SECTION 6A SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ANY AD VALOREM TAX ON REAL PROPERTY SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE PERCENT OF THE ASSESSED VALUE OF THE PROPERTY ACCORDING TO THE RECORDS OF THE COUNTY ASSESSOR AS OF DECEMBER 31, 1998, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY LAW SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND PROCEDURES TO IMPLEMENT THE ABOVE PROVISIONS.
