A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO COMMEMORATE THE CONVENING OF THE FOURTH SESSION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN JACKSONBOROUGH, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN JANUARY OF 1782, AS A RESULT OF THE CONTINUED BRITISH OCCUPATION OF CHARLESTON, SUBSEQUENT TO THE DEFEAT OF THE BRITISH AT YORKTOWN IN OCTOBER OF 1781, AND TO CONSIDER HOLDING A COMMEMORATIVE EVENT IN 2007 IN JACKSONBOROUGH TO HONOR AND CELEBRATE THE CONVENING OF THE JACKSONBOROUGH ASSEMBLY.
