S 0227 General Bill, By McConnell

Summary: Revenue Department may waive penalty, interest when innocent taxpayer unaware of new tax law within certain time period

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-58-185, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PAYMENT BY AN INNOCENT TAXPAYER, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE WAIVER OF A PENALTY OR PENALTY AND INTEREST INCURRED BY AN INNOCENT TAXPAYER FOR FAILURE TIMELY TO PAY AN AMOUNT DUE IF THE FAILURE ARISES WITHIN EIGHTEEN MONTHS OF A NOVEL INTERPRETATION OR APPLICATION OF AN EXISTING LAW OR FROM AN OPINION RENDERED ON AN EXISTING LAW WHICH WAS PREVIOUSLY SILENT ON THE APPLICATION OF A PENALTY OR INTEREST.
