A Bill to empower the South Carolina Textile Industry Study Committee to study the restrictions and quarantines on textile and apparel imports that are imposed on the exportation of South Carolina produced textiles and apparels by any importing nation and to further study the feasibility of placing similar restrictions on textiles and apparels imported into South Carolina.
