A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 1-5-40 SO AS TO AUTHORIZE THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO RETAIN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS IN A FISCAL YEAR OF CORPORATION AND UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE FILING FEES PAID TO THAT OFFICE TO BE EXPENDED FOR COMPUTER EQUIPMENT UPGRADES, MAINTENANCE, AND SOFTWARE FOR THE CORPORATE DIVISION'S COMPUTER SYSTEM, TO ALLOW THE CARRYFORWARD OF UNEXPENDED FEES TO THE SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEAR, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THIS PROVISION CONTINUES TO APPLY WITH RESPECT TO ANY SUCCESSOR AGENCY CHARGED WITH RECEIVING AND MAINTAINING THE CORPORATION AND UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE FILINGS REQUIRED BY LAW.
