H*3049 (Rat #0139, Act #0077 of 1993) General Bill, By J.L.M. Cromer

A Bill to amend Section 40-47-10, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to composition of the State Board of Medical Examiners, so as to delete the requirement that the member representing each Congressional District must practice in that District, delete provisions relating to staggered terms for initial appointments, and make technical corrections.
