A Bill to amend Section 44-51-70, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to commencement of judicial hospitalization proceedings for drug addicts, so as to provide for nonemergency hospitalization proceedings and to reduce from two to one the number of physicians that must examine and certify that an individual is an addict and to provide him counsel if one is not retained.
