Summary: Golf course operated by Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Department must not be privatized

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 51-3-55 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANY GOLF COURSE AND RELATED FACILITIES OPERATED AS PART OF THE STATE PARK SYSTEM BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND TOURISM AT WHICH THE FEES AND CHARGES PAID BY MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR AT THE FACILITY AT LEAST EQUAL THE COST OF OPERATION OF GOLF COURSE AND FACILITIES FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR MUST BE OPERATED BY EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT AND NOT BY THIRD PARTY PRIVATE CONTRACTORS, AND TO DEFINE "COST OF OPERATION" FOR THIS PURPOSE.
